Saturday, July 27

Depart Detroit on UA #3748 at 5:48pm. Arrive Newark at 7:38pm then connect with our overnight flight, UA #25 at 10:25pm to Shannon.

Sunday, July 28

Céad míle fáilte! Arrive Shannon Airport at 9:45am. Meet our Irish driver/guide in the arrivals hall and start our Irish journey. We will travel through the Burren, an impressive region with a limestone landscape that cultivates unique flora and megalithic tombs and monuments older than Egypt's pyramids. We'll stop for **tea & scones** and an opportunity to stretch our legs a little after our international flight. We'll then visit the magnificent **Cliffs of Moher** which rise 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. Time to walk to the cliff edge and breathe in the fresh Irish air. Arrive in Galway City with a bit of time to explore or to rest before dinner at the hotel.

Overnight: Park House Hotel, Galway (D)

Monday, July 29

Today we'll drive to Rossaveal to board **a ferry to Inis Mor** the largest of the Aran Islands. On arrival, you'll join a bus tour around the island including a visit to Dún Aengus, an eleven-acre prehistoric stone cashel. Or perhaps rent a bike or take a walk around the town of Kilroan, visiting the local shops and maybe pick up an Aran Sweater. Return to Gakway for dinner with the group. **Overnight: Park House Hotel, Galway (B, D)**

Tuesday, July 30

After breakfast we will begin our journey through the Connemara. Relax and enjoy the scenery of the wild and wonderful Connemara region. Visit the **Connemara History & Heritage Center.** The Center offers a unique insight into the history and heritage of this beautiful part of the West of Ireland. See how turf (peat) is cut and sample a drop of 'poitín'. The drive continues through the magnificent Connemara Peninsula and the stunning views of boglands and misty mountains. We will arrive in the afternoon with time to enjoy the resort.

Wednesday, July 31

Today we'll experience the ancient tradition of **Falconry**, which has been handed down through the generations for over 4000 years, is the art of hunting with birds of prey. At Mount Falcon Estate, Ballina. Co. Mayo, we can enter this world with their resident Falconers who will personally introduce us to the various birds of prey on display. Next, we'll take a **Mill Tour at Foxford Woollen Mills**. An intriguing tale woven in the west of Ireland. We'll see the mill as it's run today, where master craftspeople are creating contemporary designs that they deliver all over the world. Explore the history of Foxford Woollen Mills and learn about techniques that have been passed down through generations. **Overnight: Breaffy House Resort, Castlebar (B, D)**

Thursday, August 1

On our way to Co. Donegal we will stop at the **Belleek Pottery Visitor Centre.** Here we will learn how the famous pottery is made. Established in 1857 Belleek Pottery holds a very special place in the cultural and commercial heritage of County Fermanagh. Nestling on the banks of the River Erne this imposing building is home to the world-famous Belleek Fine Parian china and to one of Ireland's top five visitor attractions. We'll continue to The Sandhouse Hotel and enjoy the views overlooking the stunning Rossnowlagh Beach. **Overnight: Sandhouse Hotel, Co. Donegal (B, D)**

Friday, August 2

After breakfast this morning we will depart Co. Donegal. We'll stop in Derry where a **local guide will take us on a walking tour** around Derry, still mostly encircled by its medieval city walls. The walls are among the best-preserved city fortifications in the Western World. We will learn about the city's fascinating history while enjoying some spectacular scenery. We'll arrive later this afternoon in Belfast City. **Overnight: The Grand Central Hotel, Belfast (B, D)**

Saturday, August 3

After breakfast we will enjoy a scenic drive along the beautiful Antrim coast. After some touring and perhaps a few photo stops, it's on to the **Giant's Causeway**, a mass of 40,000 hexagonal basalt columns formed over 60 million years ago. Legends about giants abound, especially Finn McCool, a hardy Ulster hero. We'll return to Belfast for dinner at the hotel. Perhaps visit the famous Crown Liquor Saloon this evening. **Overnight: The Grand Central Hotel, Belfast (B, D)**

Sunday, August 4

This morning a **local guide will take us on a two-hour tour** through Belfast City, rich in Victorian and Edwardian architecture. We'll depart Belfast for Dublin City. This afternoon we'll continue to the **Guinness Storehouse** where we can explore exhibits with over 250 years of creative history. The tour ends in the Gravity Bar with a pint of Guinness and a great 360-degree view of Dublin. Dinner is on our own this evening. **Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin (B)**

Monday, August 5

After breakfast, enjoy a sightseeing tour around Dublin City. We will see elegant Georgian squares and houses, colorful parks, and bustling shopping areas. The city has been molded through the centuries with many architectural styles, reflecting the economic, political and artistic influences. Stop at Trinity College to see **the Book of Kells**, an 8th century illuminated manuscript of the gospels and see the Old Library. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure before meeting back with the group for our last dinner together in Ireland.

Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin (B, D)

Tuesday, August 6

After an early breakfast we will drive to Dublin Airport to depart on UA # 22 at 9:20am. We'll arrive at Newark at 11:35am where we will meet our connecting flight, UA #3503 at 2:00pm, arriving Detroit at 3:59pm. (**B**)
